Make sure you complete the following on or before the deadlines listed below; failure to do so will forfeit your spot in these programs:

Reservation and Fee

- Complete the YEA! Media Release/Waiver form and pay \$30 to reserve your spot; this covers two in-school programs and an off-site field trip!
- Fees may be paid in cash or online through the school website. Payment or proof of online payment must be submitted with YEA! paperwork – no incomplete paperwork will be accepted.
- **Note:** the last day for online payment is 10/15/2017 and the last day for cash payment is 10/16/2017.

Experimental Science 3 Honors classes from South Plantation High School will be taking part in a unique 3-part hands-on, place-based educational experience this fall. This program consists of 2 school-based hands-on experiences and one off-site field trip delivered by the Youth Environmental Alliance (YEA!).

All programs tie directly to the curriculum and provide new and engaging ways to learn key content. School-based programs will be delivered on campus during normal instructional time.

Cry of the Water

The first program in the series is an interactive experience that engages students in making a difference to our globe using Florida's ecosystems as case studies. This hands-on program teaches students

environmental issues in a fun and scientific manner that facilitates awareness and empowers students to make conscious decisions about protecting our planet.

Think Globally, Act Locally

The third program in the series allows students the opportunity to engage in habitat stewardship on school grounds. After learning the principles of Florida-friendly landscaping, students will identify an area on campus in need of remediation and transform it into a "NatureScape" featuring native plants that are both wildlife and people friendly.
