### In-School Programs

South Plantation's 9<sup>th</sup> grade Magnet students are taking part in three unique in-school "field trips" this year that take place during their regular class time. ### Off-Campus Trips

Field trips off campus are full day programs which use a hands-on approach that incorporates science, math, social studies and research. In the outdoor laboratory, participants will carry out analysis and experimentation using data and specimens collected in the field, run by the Science Eye.
