

Site Visit: March 5, 12, 13, or 14, 2019

Check List

Please make sure you have done the following to prepare for the trip:

- **Paperwork**

Fill out and return both forms correctly and completely. The school permission slip and the Science Eye liability/ medical form are both due two weeks before the trip. Incomplete/ missing forms will not NOT be accepted. Deadline is

2/19/2019

- **Clothing & ID - Mandatory**

Wear closed toe shoes, collared Magnet Shirt, and long pants. You will be walking part of the time, and riding on a tram. Appropriate dress is essential for your safety. You must bring your ID.

- **Science Research Journal**

Bring your blue Magnet notebook

- **Food & Drink**

Bring lunch and drinks as well as a reusable water bottle – you will not be able to purchase food/ drinks on site.

- **Don't forget**

Bring a hat, sunscreen, and insect repellent.

- **Optional**

Binoculars, extra snacks, money for snacks or souvenirs from gift shop.

Site Visits are NOT Optional; Planned Part of Magnet

Everglades National Park is a special partner with the magnet program; therefore a unique field study is planned for the trip at the park. The trip is split into three days, because of the number of students: March 5th, 12th, 13th, or 14th.

For the trip to ENP, students will have to make sure you arrive to school on time and prepared. The buses will leave South Plantation High at 8:15 a.m. Students will return to the school around 4:00 p.m. Be aware that students need to have their parents pick them upon returning to campus.

All participants must wear **closed-toed shoes, magnet shirt, and school ID**. Be sure to pack for the weather. Code of conduct rules and consequences are enforced on the trip.

NO electronics or phones out during the trip – exception: camera use

No food or drinks are available at the park so bring your own lunch. Coolers will be on the bus, and students must mark their name in permanent marker. No bags or backpacks allowed on the bus. Students need to bring sun screen, insect repellent, a hat, science journal, and a pencil – for data collection.

If trip is cancelled, students will attend their regular class schedule – school-wide refund policy enforced.

Students who have had behavior issues in class are not permitted to travel on this trip. Those who do not attend the field trip must complete the alternate assignment.

Examine the different habitats found in the park and record water quality data in your Magnet research journal.

Shark Valley
