The trip to Zoo Miami has been planned especially for 10th Grade Magnet Environmental Science classes.

The trip will be the first for Magnet students to see *Florida: Mission Everglades* which encourages them to take a deeper look at the wildlife in their own back yard.

They will see 60 species of iconic Florida animals like the roseate spoonbill, the Florida panther, black bear, burrowing owl, gopher tortoise, bald eagle, alligators, crocodiles, tortoises and more.

interactive exhibits such as a crawl through tunnel at the crocodile habitat, a slide-through the North American river otter exhibit, a brown and white pelican encounter, a pop-up blind at the Florida panther/black bear exhibit, .

Students will attend a special presentation and notice the diverse fauna from the world and understand the conservation achieved by Zoo Miami.

MISSION EVERGLADES

Explore the new Everglades exhibit which features crocodiles and native birds.

LOSTMAN'S RIVER

Take a boat ride or crawl through a "tunnel" to see the animals up close.

ACTIVITIES

Enjoy feeding a giraffe or parrot or take a camel ride with your friends.
