Please make sure you do the following to prepare for the trip:

- **Clothing & ID – Mandatory**
Wear closed-toe shoes, yellow Magnet T-shirt, and School-Board appropriate shorts; and bring a change of clothes.
You must bring your ID. Be sure to pack for and dress for the weather – we are outside all day. **Bring sunscreen, insect repellent, a hat, sunglasses, and Magnet notebook with a pencil** – for data collection.

Dr. Von D. Mizell-Eula Johnson State Park

Site visits are a planned part of the Magnet curriculum

Dr. Von D. Mizell-Eula Johnson State Park (formerly known as John U. Lloyd) is a beautiful and scenic park with a mangrove-lined waterway ideal for observing the flora and fauna commonly found in Florida's mangrove and tidal zone systems.

During this trip 12th grade Magnet student will be continuing their education on important field practices like sustainable resources and environmentally safe fishing practices. They will learn how to seine for the first time and will also continue to practice catch and release of aquatic organism that they were first introduced to in the 9th grade. We will also celebrate their participation in the Environmental Magnet Program by ending the day with a barbecue.

For this trip students need to ensure they arrive to school on time and prepared. The buses will leave South Plantation High at 8:15 a.m. Students will return to the school **after 3:00 p.m. Upon returning to campus, students either drive their own cars home or a parent must pick them up.**

We will have coolers on the bus, and students must label snacks/drinks with their name in permanent marker. **No backpacks allowed on the bus...only Magnet field trip drawstring bag allowed.**

SBBC code of conduct rules and consequences are enforced during these programs – on and off campus. Safety is our top priority!

Students who violate the rules may have their field trip privileges revoked, removed from current and upcoming field trips, and any special activities within the Magnet program.

If the trip is cancelled or postponed, students will attend their regular class schedule – school-wide refund policy enforced, if applicable.

Seining**Dania Beach**

Students will round up fish and steer them into a seine net. They will then count and identify the marine organisms.

Fishing**Catch and release**

Students will identify the fish they catch and then release them. Circle hooks will be used to avoid injury to the fish.

Beach-Cleanup**Data collection of commonly discarded trash**

Students will collect, identify and count trash found on the beach.
