1. When is Graduation?

May 31, 2019 @ 2:00pm

2. Where will graduation be held?

Nova Southeastern University Rick Case Arena at the Don Taft University Center

3. What time do I need to arrive on graduation day?

All graduates need to be in the arena by 12:00 pm. Report to your seats.

4. Where do graduates and family members park for graduation?

Parking will be in the surface lots adjacent to the Nova Southeastern University Arena. All individual vehicles must have a PRE-PAID parking pass. Vehicles without pre-paid parking passes will be directed to the outer lots of Broward College and charged a \$10.00 parking fee. Pre-paid parking passes can be purchased in Room 180 for \$7.00 CASH & CARRY beginning April 29, 2019.

5. How many tickets do I get?

Each graduate will be given 4 tickets. Students who completed their required 40 service hours prior to winter break will receive an additional ticket. All tickets will be distributed at Cap and Gown distribution on May 29, 2019 between 8:00 – 11:00 am.

6. When is rehearsal for graduation?

Graduation rehearsal is Tuesday, May 21, 2019 before afternoon senior exams in the Gym at 8:00 am. Rehearsal is mandatory for all students participating in the May 30, 2019 graduation ceremony.

7. How do I receive my graduation regalia and tickets

All students will receive their cap, gown, and graduation tickets on distribution day at the football stadium on Wednesday, May 29, 2019 beginning at 8:00 am. Please refer to the schedule below for your distribution time. You may NOT pick up your regalia earlier than your assigned time. Students unable to attend on this date will be able pick up their regalia on Thursday, May 31, 2019 from 1:00 pm – 3:00 pm in the Media Center.

9. How can I obtain special cords, medals, or other recognition for clubs or activities?

10. How can I order graduation pictures?

The representatives will be available during the mandatory rehearsal on May 21th at 8:00 am. GradImages is the official photographer for commencement. Your proofs will be available after the ceremony. To view your proofs online, please visit www.gradimages.com. Pictures may be ordered online, by phone, or by mail. If you have any questions please contact Customer Service at 800-261-2376 or via email at gisevice@gradimages.net. Pre-register with GradImages by visiting www.gradimages.com, and clicking on the Pre-Event Registration at the bottom of the page. This provides them with the most correct and up-to-date contact information and ensures the delivery of your graduation proofs in a timely manner. You may register your email and up to 6 emails of loved ones who would like to share in your accomplishment by viewing and ordering photos.

11. How can others watch the graduation ceremony?

The graduation ceremony will be streamed live from NSU. A link will be posted on the school website.

12. How will I know if I have satisfied my obligations?

Check your virtual counselor account before May 23, 2019. Students with any obligation balance (money, books, uniforms, etc.) will need to bring their balance to \$0.00 before they will receive graduation regalia. Completion of the online Senior Survey is a requirement and will also count as an obligation if not completed by May 23, 2019.

13. What is the appropriate attire for graduation?

Gentlemen: Dark pants (black), Dark shoes (black), White collared shirt, Dark tie

*Ladies: Dress or skirt at knee length (not below gown), Dark shoes (black) *consider heel height*

PLEASE do not bring any purses or bags to the graduation ceremony. There is no storage available.

14. When will I receive my diploma?

Diplomas and certificates of completion will be given to all students at the conclusion of the ceremony. Graduates will return their gowns after the recessional and receive diplomas prior to exiting the NSU arena. Please make arrangements for meeting your guests outside the arena.
