Shark Tagging

Nova Southeastern University Oceanographic Center

Nova Southeastern University Oceanographic Center, who partners with South Plantations Magnet Program, allows us to take part in their research-based shark tagging program.

Students will take part in a boat trip over our local coral reefs, capturing sharks, identifying, collecting, and tagging individual sharks.

Students will be on the water all day. Hydration and sun protection are serious issues on the water. Students should be in good health and ready for a long day of fun work.

Since this field trip is all outside, if there is inclement weather, the trip will either be rescheduled or cancelled.

Students should wear school board appropriate shorts and their Magnet T-shirt. Bathing suits should also be worn under clothing. Closed toed shoes with hard soles and a back strap are required.

Sunscreen or sun block, hats, and clothing that can prevent sun burns should be used. Students should bring a complete change of clothes for the ride home and a plastic bag for wet clothing and a towel.

TIMES

Parent to drop off at 6:30AM at NSU Oceanographic Institute located in Dr. Von D. Mizell-Eula Johnson State Park. **Pick up by 5:00PM...earlier if we finish early.**

LUNCH

Lunch and snacks are **NOT** provided. Bring **water** and food along with snacks that you will want on the boat.

DO NOT BE LATE. The boat must leave the dock on time.

Apply sunscreen often while on the trip. It is recommended that you bring two towels and a reusable water bottle.
