

Site Visit: March 4, 8, or 9, 2022

Check List

Please make sure you have done the following to prepare for the trip:

- **Payment - \$50 DUE: 2/25/2022**
The field trip fee must be paid in full. You may pay online at: tinyurl.com/SharkValley22
- **Paperwork**
 1. Permission slip/ medical form
 2. Science Eye waiver form

All pages filled out and signed (double-sided) and turned in by **2/25/2022**. Must provide online payment #
- **Clothing & ID - Mandatory**
Wear closed toe shoes, collared Magnet Shirt, and long pants. You will be walking part of the time, and riding on a tram. Appropriate dress is essential for your safety. You must bring your ID.
- **Magnet Research Notebook**
Bring your green Magnet notebook for observations and data collection.
- **Food & Drink**
Bring lunch and drinks as well as a reusable water bottle
- **Don't forget**
Bring a hat, sunscreen, and insect repellent.
- **Optional**
Binoculars, extra snacks, money for snacks or souvenirs from gift shop.

Site Visits are NOT Optional; Planned Part of Magnet Curriculum

Everglades National Park is a special partner with the magnet program; therefore, a unique field study is planned for the trip at the park. The trip is split into four days, because of the number of students: March 4th, 8th, or 9th.

For the trip to ENP, students will have to make sure you arrive to school on time and prepared. The buses will leave South Plantation High at 8:15 a.m. Students will return to the school around 4:00 p.m. Be aware that students need to have their parents pick them upon returning to campus.

All participants must wear **closed-toed shoes, magnet shirt, and school ID**. Be sure to pack for and dress for the weather – we are outside all day. You may wear a hat and sunglasses

NO electronics or phones out during the trip – exception: camera use

Coolers will be on the bus, and students must mark their name in permanent marker. No bags or backpacks allowed on the bus. Students need to bring sun screen, insect repellent, a hat, magnet notebook, and a pencil – for data collection.

SBBC code of conduct rules and consequences are enforced during these programs – on and off campus. Safety is our top priority!

Students who violate the rules may have their field trip privileges revoked, removed from current and upcoming field trips, and any special programs within the Magnet program.

If the trip is cancelled or postponed, students will attend their regular class schedule – school-wide refund policy enforced, if applicable.

Those who do not attend the field trip must complete the alternate assignment
