

What to Bring/Wear?

- 1 or 2 water bottles (we provide a water cooler for refills)
- A light lunch (drink, fruit/vegetable snacks, sandwich, & cookies are plenty ALL FOOD MUST BE BROUGHT, FOOD CANNOT BE PURCHASED ON SITE)
- Sunscreen
- Hat
- Sunglasses
- Long pants (full length pants capris and long shorts are <u>not</u> acceptable; ideal pants are nylon zip-offs and thick tights, jeans and sweat pants are acceptable, but heavy and take a long time to dry)
- Short sleeve T-shirt
- *Long sleeve shirt to wear OVER the short sleeve shirt
- <u>Closed-toe secured to feet shoes</u>: tie or Velcro shoes (no open-toe, open-sided, open-heeled, slip-ons, sandals, mesh or neoprene topped, or flip-flops → old tennis shoes or boots are recommended; rain boots/wading boots are acceptable, but NOT recommended)
- *Rain jacket/poncho depending on the weather
- Optional: Camera (water proof or in a plastic lock bag for protection; WE ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY ELECTRONIC DEVICES)
- Optional: Binoculars

*WEATHER DEPENDENT: IF THE WEATHER IS WARM/HOT, WEAR LIGHT-WEIGHT FABRIC CLOTHING; IF THE WEATHER

IS COOL/COLD, WEAR HEAVIER FABRIC CLOTHING
PLEASE CHECK THE WEATHER THE

MORNING OF, FOR THE ENTIRE DAY, TO MAKE SURE YOUR CHILD IS DRESSED

APPROPRIATELY AND PREPARED

What NOT to Bring?

- Any Electronic Mobile Devices: hand-held gaming, music, social media, etc. (cell phones are ok if used <u>ONLY</u> as a camera, please see the *Optional: Camera* above... otherwise they need to be turned off and remain in backpacks)
- Money
- Valuables (backpacks will either remain on the bus or under the pavilion)
