

# Off-Site Field Trip: 3/1 or 3/2

## Be Prepared

### □ Clothing & ID

Wear closed-toed shoes, long pants (no shorts allowed), Magnet T-shirt, and SPHS student ID! Students without their SPHS ID and/or proper attire will not be allowed on the field trip.

### □ Food & Drink

Bring a snack, lunch and drinks as well as a reusable water bottle – **refreshments are not available for purchase.**

### □ Cancellations

If any of the programs are cancelled, students will resume regular curriculum. If programs cannot be rescheduled, then the school refund policy will be in effect.

### □ Absences

As SPHS and YEA! must pay vendors and purchase supplies in advance, it is not possible to issue refunds to students who miss any of the programs.

## Site visits are not optional; Required part of Magnet Curriculum

The **A-Way with Wasted Water** program is a field-based program designed to engage students in becoming more knowledgeable about problems and solutions related to waste management. As part of this all-day field trip, students will travel to different locations as they take part in the program.

**Wakodahatchee Wetlands** (13270 Jog Road, Delray Beach, 33484)

Students will learn about how wastewater is collected, treated, and used to create habitats for native plants and animals.

Students must make sure they arrive at school on time and prepared. The buses will leave promptly at the start of first hour and will return to school in time for students to ride the bus home.

Students need to have their Magnet field notebooks and the iNaturalist app downloaded on their phone for data collection. Students need to be prepared to be outside all day: dress for the weather, bring sunscreen, insect repellent, a hat, and rain gear.

Valuables are discouraged as bags and backpacks will be stored on the bus for the duration of the trip.

If a student is excluded from the trip for failure to arrive on time or follow the rules, no refund will be issued.
